Important Instructions for Counselling

1. Eligibility for admission shall be as per the provisions of the Guru Nanak Dev University (GNDU) Admission Prospectus 2026-27.
2. **Physical presence of the candidate is mandatory.** Candidates must report at the counselling venue as per the scheduled date and time. Requests for online counselling or representation through another person will not be entertained.
3. Candidates must bring a **printed copy of the online application form** submitted during GNDU registration. The application form can be downloaded from the admission portal using the candidate's User ID and Password.
4. Candidates must produce the **original certificates** along with **two sets of self-attested photocopies** of the following documents:
 - a. Matriculation (10th) Certificate
 - b. +2 Detailed Marks Certificate (DMC)
 - c. B.P.T. DMC's, Internship Certificate and Degree
 - d. Character Certificate
 - e. Migration Certificate (where applicable)
 - f. Residence Certificate
 - g. Any other relevant certificates
5. The **Matriculation (10th) Certificate** shall serve as proof of date of birth.

6. Candidates should bring **two recent passport-size photographs**.
7. Candidates claiming reservation under any category must bring the **original Reservation Certificate, Residence Certificate, and Income Certificate (where applicable)** along with one set of self-attested photocopies, as prescribed in the GNDU Admission Prospectus 2026–27 (available at www.gnduadmissions.org).
8. The category claimed at the time of online registration **shall not be changed** at any stage of the admission process.
9. Specimen formats for Residence Certificate and other reserved category certificates are available in the **GNDU Admission Prospectus 2026–27** (available at www.gnduadmissions.org).
10. Candidates must produce a **Character Certificate** issued by the Head/Principal of the institution last attended.
11. Candidates are advised to bring the **prescribed admission fee** as mentioned in the GNDU Admission Prospectus 2026–27. The fee may also be paid through **Net Banking, Debit Card, or Credit Card**. Admission shall be confirmed only after successful payment of the prescribed fee.
12. All admissions shall be **provisional** and subject to verification of original documents and fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility conditions. If any information furnished by a candidate is found to be false or fabricated at any stage, the admission shall be cancelled.
13. Candidates are advised to carefully read the **GNDU Admission Prospectus 2026–27** for detailed eligibility conditions, reservation policy, admission rules, and other guidelines before attending counselling.
14. Candidates must attend counselling strictly according to the date and reporting time mentioned in the counselling schedule.
15. **Calling a candidate for counselling does not guarantee admission.** Admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit, fulfilment of eligibility conditions, reservation policy, verification of original documents, and availability of seats.
16. **No separate counselling letter will be issued.** Candidates should report for counselling as per the schedule published on the University website.

Important

All candidates must report to the counselling venue strictly as per the scheduled reporting time. Candidates reporting late will be considered only after the completion of counselling for the candidates whose merit ranks are being processed at that time, subject to the availability of seats.
